Park Entry

Athletes get free entry: If you're dropping off your athlete, let staff in the entry kiosk know. If you're not staying with them for the entire meet, you will need to pay the parking fee upon return for pick up.

Plan for a long drop off time: On meet days, park entrances are very busy, so plan to arrive early and wait in line before entry.

Drive responsibly and safely: Park only in designated parking spots and obey all posted speed limits, for your safety and the safety of other visitors.

Members park for free

Regional Parks members park for free at all regional parks year-round. Annual memberships are \$49-\$69. Learn more at SoCoParks.org/Member



Reminders

Display your parking pass: Please display your team's parking pass on your vehicle's dashboard. Passes are provided by your team or school.

Be courteous to other visitors: Parks and trails remain open to the public during meets. Please respect other park visitors and share the trails.

Dispose of trash properly: Dispose of trash, including water bottles, snack wrappers and pet waste, in designated trash cans.

Keep your pet leashed and under control: Leashed dogs are welcome in most regional parks.
